All violence is an offence against God
Violence against women is condemned
Abuse is oppression

o Jesus doesn't play by the rules of violence and power

8 Biggest Mistakes Churches Make About Domestic Abuse

- 1. Thinking that no one is being victimized in the congregation
- 2. Not believing the victim
- 3. Breaking confidentiality and putting the victim at risk for harm
- Confronting an abuser without regard for the safety of the victim

- 5. Believing that your church does not need to be educated about DV
- 6. Neglecting to help a victim of abuse
- 7. Teaching a wrong emphasis of headship and submission
- 8. Scolding the victim for returning to an abusive relationship



What can the church do to prevent DV? oAbolish the silence oRecognize DV is against the law oTeach healthy relationships in sermons and Bible lessons oRecognize relationship violence early on in dating relationships oDon't minimize abuse or make excuses for the abuser oPractical steps
